## THE RESNA LIST

The RESNA list is an unmoderated discussion list meant to facilitate discussions and exchange of ideas. It is open to RESNA members and non-members, but only subscribers may post messages. Appropriate postings include:

- feedback about conferences
- announcements of future conferences
- ideas for instructional courses, special sessions, morning seminars
- discussion of a particular piece of equipment
- questions about clinical problems or ideas

Basically, anything having to do with RESNA or the assistive technology field can be discussed freely.
